

MYNAG DEPARTMENTAL SITE LICENSE SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS BEFORE OPENING THE SOFTWARE PACKET. OPENING THE SOFTWARE PACKET INDICATES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

You assume responsibility for the selection of the NAG software to achieve your intended results, and for the installation, use and results obtained from the NAG software.

I. License

You may:

- i) use the NAG software on any applicable university-owned system. An applicable system is one which is owned or controlled by the department, group, or school name as the licensee.
- ii) copy the NAG software into any machine readable or printed form for backup purposes in support of your use of the NAG software on the single machine
- iii) merge portions of the NAG software into another program for your use on any applicable university-owned system (any portion of this NAG software merged with another program will continue to be subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement)
- iv) incorporate portions of the NAG software into another program and transfer or dispose of such program without further payment to NAG provided that:
 - a) the machine it is transferred to is licensed for the NAG software, or
 - b) the incorporated portions of the NAG software are not removed from the transferred or disposed program and such transfer or disposal is not for payment or profit

II. Limitations on rights and use

YOU MAY NOT COPY, MODIFY OR TRANSFER THE NAG SOFTWARE OR ANY COPY, MODIFICATION OR MERGED PORTION, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PERMITTED UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.

Your license is non-exclusive and non-transferrable. IF YOU TRANSFER POSSESSION OF ANY COPY MODIFICATION OR MERGED PORTION OF THE NAG SOFTWARE (except as expressly permitted by iv) above TO ANOTHER PARTY, YOUR LICENSE IS AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATED.

The rights granted by this Agreement shall in no event be proprietary rights and, upon termination of this Agreement, for whatever reason, all your rights under this Agreement to use the NAG software shall terminate. This Agreement does not, nor shall it be construed to give you any right, claim or title to or ownership interest in, any product, trade secret, patent, copyright, trade name, trademark or other such right owned or applied for by NAG.

III. Term of license

This license is in effect for one year. Upon completion you may terminate it by destroying the NAG software together with all copies, modifications and merged portions in any form. It will also terminate upon conditions set forth elsewhere in this Agreement or if you fail to comply with any ten-n or condition of this Agreement. You agree upon such termination to destroy the NAG software together with all copies, modifications and merged portions in any form.

IV. Limited warranty

i) NAG warrants that the NAG software, if properly used on properly functioning equipment in conjunction with the appropriate computing environment, substantially will perform the functions described in the NAG documentation included in this package.

ii) NAG warrants the media on which the NAG software is furnished to be free of defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of delivery to you as evidenced by a copy of your receipt.

iii) THE FOREGOING WARRANTIES ARE IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES AND THE NAG SOFTWARE IS PROVIDED 'AS IS' WITHOUT ANOTHER WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. THE ENTIRE RISK AS TO THE QUALITY AND PERFORMANCE OF THE NAG SOFTWARE IS WITH YOU. SHOULD THE NAG SOFTWARE PROVE DEFECTIVE, YOU (AND NOT NAG, ITS DISTRIBUTOR, OR ITS DEALERS) ASSUME THE ENTIRE COST OF ALL NECESSARY SERVICING, REPAIR OR CORRECTION EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN THE PARAGRAPH BELOW RELATING TO LMTATIONS OF REMEDIES.

SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OF IMPLIED WARRANTIES, SO THE ABOVE EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS WHICH VARY FROM STATE TO STATE.

V. Limitations of remedies

NAG'S, its Distributor's and Dealer's entire liability and your exclusive remedy shall be:

i) the correction by NAG, within a reasonable period of time, of any significant defects in performance of the NAG software which is a breach of the Limited Warranty contained in IV.i) above, the replacement of any media not meeting the Limited Warranty relating to defects in materials and workmanship specified in IV.ii) above, and which is returned to NAG or an authorized dealer (acting in this instance as NAG's agent) with a copy of your receipt, or

ii) if NAG does not correct the defect as provided in IV.i) above, or if NAG or the dealer is unable to deliver a replacement media which is free of defects in materials or workmanship as provided in IV.ii) above, you may terminate this Agreement by returning the NAG software and your money will be refunded provided such return is within 12 months of the date of purchase.

IN NO EVENT WILL NAG, OR ITS DISTRIBUTORS OR DEALERS, BE LIABLE TO YOU FOR ANY DAMAGES, INCLUDING ANY LOST PROFITS, LOST SAVINGS OR OTHER INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE NAG SOFTWARE EVEN IF NAG, ITS DISTRIBUTORS OR DEALERS HAVE BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES, OR FOR ANY CLAIM BY ANY OTHER PARTY.

SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW THE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES SO THE ABOVE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

VI. Injunctive relief

You acknowledge that the NAG software is of great value to the business of NAG and agree that, in the event of a breach of this Agreement involving the wrongful or unauthorized transfer, disclosure or use of the NAG software, NAG shall be entitled to preliminary and permanent injunctive relief, without the necessity of posting bond, and NAG shall be entitled to recover from you its reasonable attorney's fees and expenses in connection with the enforcement of its rights. The rights of NAG as provided herein shall be in addition to any and all other rights or remedies of NAG, in equity or at law.

VII. General

You may not sublicense, assign or transfer the license or the NAG software except as expressly provided in this Agreement. Any attempt otherwise to sublicense, assign or transfer any of the rights, duties or obligation hereunder is void.

In the event any term or provision of this Agreement is declared illegal or invalid for any reason, this Agreement, save for such term or provision, shall remain in full force and effect and shall be interpreted as though such illegal or invalid provision were not a part hereof.

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Illinois.

NAG hereby waives any requirement that acceptance by you of the terms and conditions of this License Agreement must be communicated by you to NAG.

YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, UNDERSTAND IT AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS. YOU FURTHER AGREE THAT IT IS THE COMPLETE AND EXCLUSIVE STATEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN US WHICH SUPERCEDES ANY PROPOSAL OR PRIOR AGREEMENT, ORAL OR WRITTEN, AND ANY OTHER COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN US RELATING TO THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS AGREEMENT.
